




TTPYC Commodore's Trophy Race, August 2, 2025

The Commodore's Trophy Race started on time August 2nd. Winds were light, maybe 3 to 5 kts. There was a flood tidal current pushing boats South and East towards the shore and the City of Des Moines Pier. All of the boats in the fleet were experiencing difficulty steering. A short course was set with multiple opportunities to shorten. Greg Zaputil and ZZZAP from the Royal Victoria Yacht Club took the gold burgee and our own Brian Newman and GADGET won the Cruising Class. Following the race we gathered at the Quarter Deck. Awards were presented, food and beverage consumed and a swell time was had by all.

The Race Committee decided to abandon the TTPYC Pursuit Race scheduled for Saturday August 9^{th} . RRS Rule 27.3 Before the starting signal, the RC may for any reason ... abandon the race and hoist the N over A flags... This is a 10 mile race with no provision to shorten and the forecast is abysmal.



I wish to thank everybody who has participated in this year's cruising and remind those who want to be considered for cruise boat of the year to complete their application which is attached to this month's email.




