Duwamish Head Race

The Duwamish Head race is our signature racing event for the year. Our Duwamish Head Race is being held on January 5, 2018. We need volunteers to help with parking visiting boats on the Friday afternoon and evening before the race. We don't expect people to stay for the entire day, but whatever time you could offer would be very helpful and also a great way to show other crews what a great club we are. Visiting boats begin arriving about 1:00 in the afternoon and continue until about 8:00 Friday night. The majority arrive in the late afternoon and early evening. Many will need to raft, which is where the real help needs to come in. We need hands willing to guide guests to open slips and helping them tie off. Once our guests have been secured, we need members to help welcome them with a warm beverage and something to eat. Bluntly, we need people to offer some soups, chowders, and snacks in the party tent on the dock. The party tent is heated by the way. We also need help with the breakfast on Saturday morning.

We also need help with the starting sequence for the race. We need people to help with the starting and finishing sequences. Volunteers will be helping with the flag sequence that sets each class off for its day of racing. We will also need several people to help with the recording of finishing times and identifying sail numbers at the conclusion of the race. Fortunately, there is a considerable window of time between the starting and finishing activities so people do not have to commit to the entire day. Volunteers could commit for either the starts or the finish, and if they choose both.
