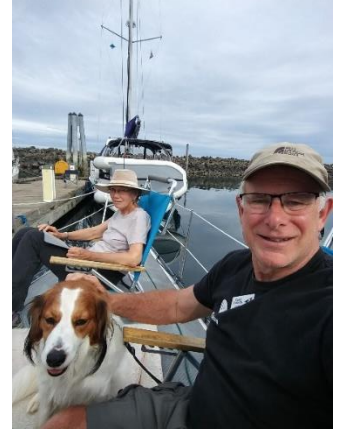

Racing News

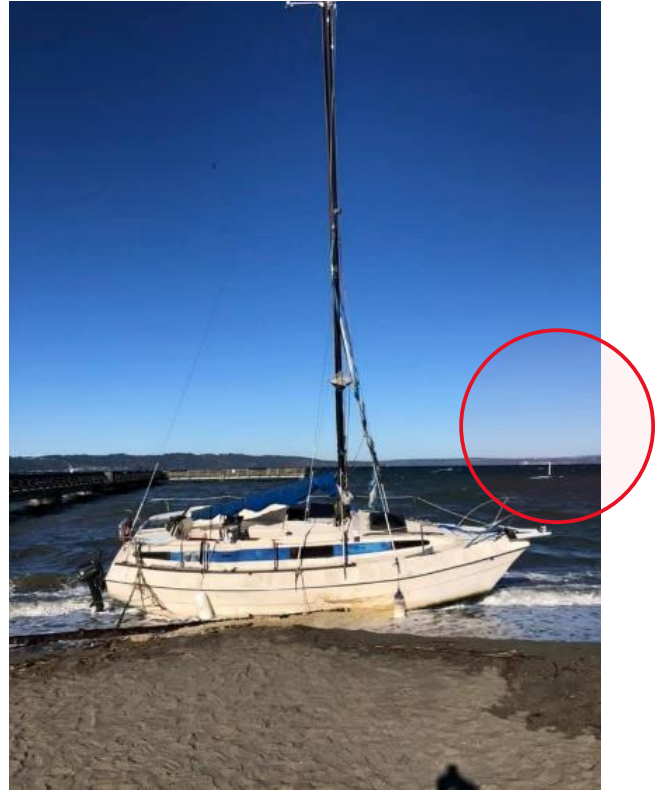
Duane Rubash Race Fleet Captain
